Upon communicating the LEARN opportunity to students we would appreciate if you can underline the following steps:

Step 1: ONE representative of the team should fill out the following form: <u>https://bit.ly/3XnnO1G</u> by 24.03.2023 Step 2: Teams should take part in the kick-off session taking place via Zoom on 04.04.2023. Depending on slot selected (midday or afternoon), they should enter via Zoom link provided within the community group in the SFF platform or slide 4. Step 3: Teams must sign into the SFF Community platform by latest 05.04.2023 and join SFF Phase 1 LEARN (Spring 2023) community Step 4: Teams should provide a description of their project (post their project) by latest10.04.2023 in the SFF Phase 1- LEARN (Spring 2023) community group under the 'Projects' tab

Important notes:

- → At least 1 team member should always be present in all the sessions.
- → Attending all sessions is important (entire 7,5 hours of exchange). Teams who miss one of these important sessions will be released from the program.
- → There are two time slots for each session; Midday (from 12:00 CET) and Afternoon (from 16:00). Students are free to choose only one from these session periods (Midday or Afternoon) and always appear only in that session. Shifting or changing session preference is not possible after the application.
- → Teams will have access to all sessions via platform but we always recommend that they mark the slots in their calendars.
