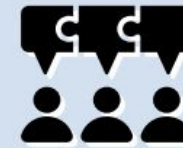

Purpose

The first Kick Off session is dedicated for onboarding student teams in SFF LEARN program and providing to them an updated information about SFF project verticals.

During the session, student teams are going to meet up with the LEARN program managers who will explain the “rules of the game”, platform tools and other relevant project details.

Furthermore, teams will meet SFF domain experts from different verticals for obtaining the valuable input around their area of interest (Food, Healthcare, Urban Mobility, Energy, Manufacturing, Circular Economy).

Student teams then have to join a breakout room of the vertical, which they have selected in their application form. In Breakout rooms, teams get input from SFF domain experts and have the chance for Q&A.

Purpose

In this session, LEARN managers are going to share the list of Trio Groups, where 3 teams with different characteristics (such as education background, country of origin, etc.) are grouped together to help each other in developing their project ideas. These Trio groups will co-work together until the final 5th session.

During the session, Trio group members will go into breakout rooms, where they introduce themselves and their (possible) project ideas to peers, discuss & book a domain expert that fits all of them jointly, start working on a template that each team needs to present in the upcoming 3rd session.

Between 2nd and 3rd sessions, all teams have to upload their project pitch decks on the SFF Platform.

Purpose

Each Trio group (consisting of 3 teams) that has been formed in session 2 has an individual 1x1 meeting with a domain expert in the breakout room.

Within 1 hour, all 3 teams of a trio group are get a personalized feedback regarding their identified problem area, selected customer group(s), market competition, and product prototype.

For the upcoming session 4, Teams from a Trio group are expected to integrate and present their learning to the same domain expert. Moreover, teams present their business to domain experts (Supportive materials, like information about Business Model Canvas, will be provided via the SFF platform)

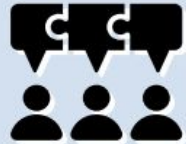

Similar to session 3, a Trio group meets with the domain expert in a breakout room. Each team of a Trio group has the same time to present their learnings from the last input session and receive feedback. Moreover, teams now present their business models, and refine by using their knowledge from the program resources and beyond.

This is the last input session before the final presentation event. Therefore, domain experts will also help teams prepare their presentation and pitching skills.

At the end, LEARN managers will announce winner teams in different categories, granting "Wild Cards" (a direct placement into Phase 2 – Match & Start, without any selection & assessments) and other prizes.
